



DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Here is a reminder of some of the systems that have been put in place in order to help to stop the spread of the virus and to help keep as many children in school as possible.

It's extremely important that the bubbles are kept separate, that social distancing is maintained in the queues and that parents move swiftly through the playground, to allow the next bubble to enter on time.

Please remember the following:

- Arrive punctually at your bubble's time:

Bubble	Drop off time	Pick up time
Year 6 + Year 4	8:45 am	3:10 pm
Year 5 + Year 3	8:55 am	3:20 pm
Year 2 + Year 1	9:05 am	3:30 pm
Nursery + Reception	9:15 am	3:00 pm

- If you are early, please don't join the queue with the previous bubble – wait on the other side of Drury Lane.
- All parents (including Early Years) should please queue southwards down Drury Lane, towards Aldwych.
- Maintain social distancing in the queue.
- Only one adult per family.
- Please don't wait in the playground after picking up your child, so that the next bubble can enter the playground promptly. If you need to speak to your child's teacher, please request a phone call or email via office@stcd.co.uk.
- Toilets on the playground are out of use after school. Children will have the opportunity to go to the toilet before the end of the day.
- Any early pick-ups need to be requested in writing.
- Any children whose parents or carers arrive after their pick up time will have to be taken to the Fit For Sport after school club and there will be a charge for these late pick-ups.
- You will have noticed more adults (both staff and parents) wearing face coverings. When people wear face coverings, it can help others to feel reassured and safe. It may be a good idea when you are dropping off and collecting your children to consider wearing a face covering
