Nursery & Reception ☺ Here are some learning activities you could complete this week.

<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Learn about patterns. Take a look at this: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zf33y9q/articles/z6jwkmn Copy patterns and create your own! What else could you use to make a pattern?</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>Try following, tracing and copying some pencil patterns with your finger, a pencil or even your toe!</p>  <p>Write a list of the animals you found in the book 'Rumble in the Jungle' by Giles Andreae. You could create a fact file. Write down words to describe each animal (your adult at home can write them down if this is tricky) or even draw the animal's habitat!</p>

<p>Personal, Social & Emotional Development</p> 	<p>Watch to the story of 'The Scorpion and The Frog' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8ImSSg9ZY6o Can people change? What should I do? How do I make choices? Am I responsible for my actions? Think carefully.</p>
<p>Communication & Language</p> 	<p>Listen to the book 'Rumble in the Jungle' by Giles Andreae, retold by the Early Years team from school. What sounds do the animals make? Play a describing game. Could you describe one of the animals to a family member so they can correctly guess which animal you are thinking of?</p>
<p>Expressive Arts & Design</p> 	<p>Learn about an artwork by Henri Rousseau called <i>Surprise!</i> Take a look: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yhYXMFbod38 Draw your own tiger in a Rainforest. What kind of media will you use...? Pencils, paint, pens, crayons?</p>
