<p><b>Understanding the World</b></p> 	<p>Find out more about different animals. <p><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>Plan your own story set in the jungle... Use the story planning template. You might imagine the story in your mind and tell it to an adult who can write it down for you. Or, with some help from an adult you can author a story set in the jungle with your own writing or drawing!</p>

<p><b>Personal, Social &amp; Emotional Development</b></p> 	<p>Think about the places that animals live. How would a lion feel about living at the zoo? How do you feel about having to stay in your house during lockdown? What do you think about the zoo and the wild? Discuss this with an adult.</p>

<p><b>Expressive Arts &amp; Design</b></p> 	<p>Draw some different zoo animal and cut them out. Use Lego or objects from your house to create a rainforest habitat or a zoo for the animals to 'live in.' See if you can move like the animals.</p>
