



Getting Started with Google Classroom

What is Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is a free Google platform that aims to simplify distributing and assessing learning in a paperless way. This term, teachers will be using Google Classroom to share resources and guidance for learning, and to send messages (written and video) to their classes. Pupils can use it to keep connected to school and to complete home learning. It is a free resource that can be accessed from any device connected to the internet - laptops, desktop computers, chrome books, tablets or mobile phones.

Username & Password

Each child has a unique username and password to log on to their own class in Google Classroom. A separate email will be sent to you with this information for your child/children. Children sign in with their username and password.

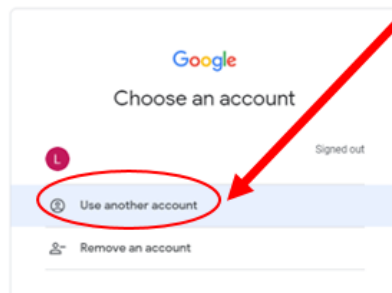

If parents have a google account on their laptop or PC, select the option 'use another account'. (In this case the parent account is Lou Smith).



Once the child has reached their 'sign in' page, they should follow these steps to enter their classroom:

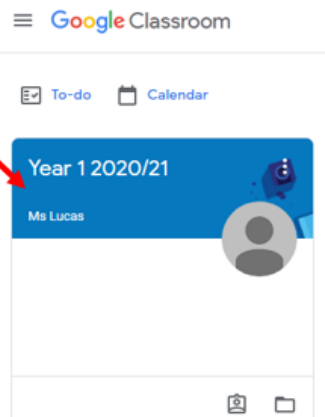
1. To sign in, pupils should enter their username (see separate email) and then click the 'Next' button



2. Now enter their unique password. Then click 'Next'.



3. Click on the class title to enter the virtual classroom.



Using Google Classroom

You will see the following options as tabs at the top of the screen:



Stream

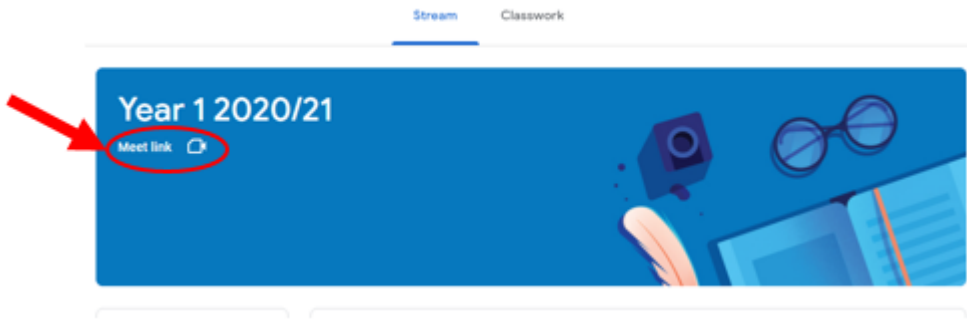
This is where your child will see posts from their teachers. Posts may contain reminders and announcements to the whole class.

Classwork

This is where your child will access Weekly Learning Sheets, guidance and learning resources set by their teacher.

Google Meet

You will be able to access 'Meet' video sessions by clicking on the link in the class title bar. Please note that this link will only work at the scheduled time set by your teacher.
