Items from 500 years ago	Items we use today



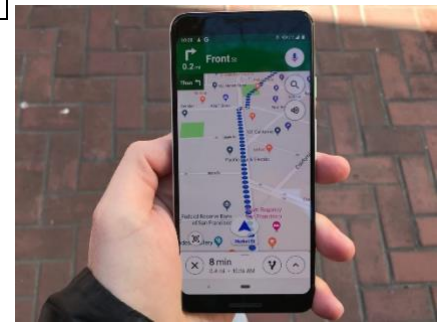
A caravel
