English: Claude in the City 	<p>Lesson 1 – Punctuation and grammar lesson: Writing different types of sentences: statements, questions, exclamation sentences and commands using the correct punctuation. Refer to PowerPoint for lesson. Write different types of sentences that go with our Claude story.</p> <p>Lesson 2- <i>I can write a persuasive piece of writing.</i> Think about guide books and leaflets for museums. Write a leaflet for the art gallery that Claude visits. Refer to PowerPoint for lesson. Create a draft leaflet on paper.</p> <p>Lesson 3- Edit leaflet and then create a final piece either using 2do which is set or on a paper leaflet made out of A4 paper.</p> <p>Lesson 4- <i>I can use adjectives to describe a character.</i> Create a wanted poster for the art thief. See PowerPoint.</p> <p>Lesson 5- <i>I can ask questions.</i> You are a journalist and you want to ask the police questions about the burglary. Write questions about information you want to find out. Email me your best 2 questions and I will use them to make a police press conference video.</p>
Spellings	<p>We are learning how to use apostrophes in contractions. I'll aren't can't couldn't didn't don't hasn't hadn't haven't he's they've you've You will be sent a letter about a new online spelling website which St Clement Danes has signed up to called Spelling Frame which can be used to practise this week's spellings and even take a test with this week's spellings.</p>

Topic Task: Geography 	<p>Task 1 – What is a human and physical feature of a place? See info on video to explain to children. Think about London what are the human and physical features of London? Play game on 2do on Purple Mash. Then consider why are there so many human features in London.</p> <p>Task 2- Last week the children worked on writing postcards in English. Now use this skill to write a postcard to me from London. Imagine you are being a tourist for a day and include information about landmarks that you have visited and things you might do. You can complete this activity on Purple Mash. In the 2dos there is a London Postcard activity, which includes a video to watch.</p> <p>Task 3- WEEKLY CHALLENGE: Draw a map of your local area with labels. Then draw a route on your map and follow this route on one of your daily walks.</p>
Mental Maths	<p>Work on your number bonds to 100 using multiples of 10 eg 40+60=100. How does making 10 help us? Challenge can you work on numbers that are not multiples of 10 eg 75+25=100. Find the <i>Make 100</i> game on Hit the Button: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</p>
