English: Claude in the City 	<p>This week we are looking at writing a newspaper article about the incident of the stolen sculpture from the art gallery and Claude saving the day. You may want to re-watch Video 3 of the story up to Part II on Video 4 to make sure that the children remember the details of the incident.</p> <p>See the PowerPoint for more info or you can read the story: https://youtu.be/7qtONi5eiHA. Find the powerpoint here.</p> <p>Lesson 1 – What are the features of a newspaper article? https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2yycdm/articles/z2gk9qt Work through this page on BBC Bitesize there's a video and some questions to answer. On the PowerPoint read an example of a newspaper report and look and spot the features.</p> <p>Lesson 2- I can plan a newspaper article. Look at the planning format for the newspaper article on the PowerPoint you can print it out or complete on lined paper. Think about the events of the sculpture burglary. Follow the planning format to plan your newspaper article.</p> <p>Lesson 3- I can draft a newspaper article. Write out the main recount of the event as a newspaper article. Use your plan to help you and don't forget <i>who, what, where, when why</i>.</p> <p>Lesson 4- I can edit and create a newspaper article. Edit and write up your final copy of your newspaper article including the other features e.g. headline, main story, pictures and caption. You can do this on the Purple Mash or print out the newspaper format below or even create your own newspaper on paper.</p> <p>Lesson 5- I can respond to an illustration. Watch video 4 up to when Claude meets Dr Achinbum. Look at picture of patients in doctor's office and imagine you are the doctor write out a diagnosis and treatment. Can you draw another character to wait for the doctor?</p>
Spellings	<p>This week work on words ending le el al - <i>animal apple bottle camel capital double fable hospital little metal middle pedal squirrel table towel travel tunnel</i></p> <p>Work on these or complete games on Spelling Frame and then complete the test at the end of the week.</p>
Reading	<p>Please read for 15 minutes every day. Write a reading log for each day. If you need more books there are lots of online books please check out the Reading Blog on the school website.</p>
Topic Task: Geography 	<p>Task 1 – Compare London to another place of your choice. Another country, city or another part of the UK (e.g. the countryside or near the coast) Try to compare it to a place that you have been so you can look back at photos and draw from your own knowledge of the place. List the similarities and differences; try to include human and physical features of the places.</p> <p>Task 2- As people who live in London many of you would have used the tube even if you aren't currently. The tube map is iconic for London. Talk to the children about the compass and North, South, East, West. Use a tube map to complete the Tube Map quiz on Purple Mash.</p> <p>Task 3- Weekly Challenge: Create a travel guide leaflet for London. Include places tourists should visit, how to get around, places to eat, and information about the places of interest.</p>
