<b>Maths</b>	Complete this week's <a href="#">BBC Bitesize</a> Year 3 Maths daily lesson. You could use the videos on <a href="#">White Rose</a> to help you.	
<b>English</b>	Please use <a href="#">this document</a> to guide you through this week's activities. <b>Activity 1</b> – Use pages 1-4 of the document. Compare 'Prince Cinders' with the traditional version of Cinderella that we know well. <b>Activity 2</b> – Follow pages 5-7 of the document. Plan & write your own version of the Cinderella story. <b>Activity 3</b> – Use pages 8-9 of the document. Record an interview, in role as a character from your story. <b>Activity 4</b> – Use pages 10-11 of the document. Write a letter to Miss Fostir. <b>Activity 5</b> – If you're at home for 5 days this week, you could have a go at the Pobble challenge! You'll find information about the Pobble challenge on pages 12-14 of this week's document.	
<b>Spellings</b>	This week and during the Summer, check to see how many of the words from the <a href="#">Year 3 &amp; Year 4 Spelling List</a> you already know. Then challenge yourself to learn at least ten new words before September. Your target for Year 4 will be to learn ALL of the words on this list before the end of the year, so it would be brilliant for you to give yourself a head start before September! Please also revisit and check that you know how to spell these words: <a href="#">Spellings to revise from Year 1 and Year 2</a> They are words that we use a lot in our everyday writing so we need to be able to spell them correctly each time. I have set words for you to practise and play games on <a href="#">Spelling Frame</a> . The lists will be live from Monday 13 <sup>th</sup> and throughout July and August. Bonus challenge words: <b>Egyptologist Fostiropoulos</b> ☺	
<b>Reading</b>	Please read for 15 minutes every day. Write a reading log for each day this week. With permission from your adult at home, please sign up for the Silly Squad's <a href="#">Summer Reading Challenge</a> . I can't wait to hear all about your reading when we come back to school in September!	
<b>Topic Tasks</b>	<b>Task 1</b> – Have a go at Miss Cassidy's <a href="#">Paint</a> Egyptian jewellery art challenge on <a href="#">Purple Mash</a> . <b>Task 2</b> – Who was King Tut? <a href="#">Click here</a> to find out more about this famous pharaoh. These <a href="#">TV documentaries</a> are packed full of fascinating facts too! (Remember to always ask for permission from your adult at home before watching.) <b>Task 3</b> – Complete Miss Fostir's final <i>Weekly Challenge</i> : Design an ancient Egyptian face mask. <a href="#">Click here</a> for ideas. <b>Task 4</b> – Complete this ' <a href="#">All About Me</a> ' page. Please ask your parent to email it to school so that Miss Fostir can pass it on to your new teacher who is so looking forward to getting to know you! Place Tutankhamun on your Egyptian timeline and record 5 facts about him. <b>Task 5</b> – Learn about the Egyptian ruler, <a href="#">Cleopatra</a> . Place Cleopatra on your Egyptian timeline and write 5 facts about her. <b>Miss Fostir's Summer Challenge</b> – Have you seen <a href="#">this</a> before? People call it <i>Cleopatra's Needle</i> . This famous Egyptian obelisk is only a ten-minute walk away from our school! See if you can find it during the Summer holiday. Have a close look at the hieroglyphs that have been engraved in the stone... Can you see any that you recognise or can translate?!	
<b>Times Tables</b>	This week and during the Summer holiday, keep practising these multiplication tables: <b>2, 3, 4, 5, 8 &amp; 10</b> . In Year 4, your challenge will be to learn ALL the tables up to 12 x 12 so having good, speedy recall of the tables that we've learnt this year will be a great help to you in Year 4! Complete regular <a href="#">speed tests</a> and scroll down the webpage to find many fun <a href="#">games</a> to play for practice!
