Here's a reminder of the features of <a href="#">instructions</a>.</p> <p><b>Task 5 (Friday):</b> The Story of Icarus (continued) – Persuasive writing: design and make a poster offering a reward for Icarus and Daedalus and explaining why it is important for King Minos to find them.
