Don't forget to continuously check off your <a href="#">checklist</a>! </p> <p><b>Task 4 (Thursday): EDIT</b> - Use this <a href="#">Year 4 Writing Map</a> to check for spelling, grammar, punctuation and adjectives. Have you included a quote from each side of the story?</p> <p><b>Task 5 (Friday): FINAL GOOD COPY</b> - Use your most outstanding handwriting on some high quality paper to complete the final good copy of your newspaper article about <a href="#">Odysseus and the Trojan Horse</a>.
