





<p>Topic Tasks</p>   	<p>Mon: To be able to compare Warfare in the Shang Dynasty and the Romans Click here for an introduction to the task. Parents, for further information about the Shang Dynasty, please click here.</p> <p>Tues: To be able to use influences for singing styles. You have been assigned at task on Charanga YUMU. Use this opportunity to try out some singing at home. Your latest music class is called <i>Dancing in the Streets</i>.</p> <p>Wed: To be able to understand why the Shang settled by the Yellow River.
