



Yr. 6 Home Learning



Here are some suggestions of activities that could be completed while learning at home which link more specifically to Year 6.



English -

Recently we have been working on Shackleton's Journey and Ice Trap.

Below are some ideas for writing that you could complete based on these texts.

- Write a mini – saga (a story using only 100 words) based on the expedition.
- Design a poster to advertise one of the books.
- Write a newspaper report about the safe return of the explorers.
- Design a marvellous machine that future explorers could take with them on expeditions. Draw your design and annotate it and then write an explanation of how it works.
- Write a radio script of an interview with Ernest Shackleton and Perce Blackborow.
- Create a story board based on the expedition.

Reading -


- Try to read daily.

Geography -


