Below are the learning activities that I would like you to complete this week.

<b>Maths</b>	Please complete a Maths lesson each day. White Rose and the BBC are working together to ensure resources are available for daily lessons. <b>English</b>	<b>Our topic this term is Adventures.</b> <b>Lesson 1</b> – Recap what has happened so far in the story. Write a synopsis of each chapter and then write your prediction for what will happen next. <b>Lesson 2</b> – Do not read Chapter 6 yet. From the predictions that you made in the previous lesson, write Chapter 6 - <i>Abuni!</i> in the style of Michael Morpurgo. <b>Lesson 3</b> – Read Chapter 6. What do you think it would feel like to be stung by a jelly fish? Collect your ideas and then write some 7 minute poems. Select your favourite poem to edit and improve. <b>Lesson 4</b> – Read Chapter 7. Pick one key event from the chapter and write a diary entry from the perspective of one of the characters in the story. You may decide to write from the perspective of one of the animals but if you do please make sure that their writing is up to the standard of Year 6! <b>Lesson 5</b> – Redraft your writing from the previous lessons.
<b>Spellings</b>	3 Spelling lists and tests have been set on Spellingframe. Please practise your spellings every day and then complete the tests on Friday.
<b>Reading</b>	Please read for 15 minutes daily.
<b>Topic Task</b>	<b>Task 1</b> – Science – Make notes about Electricity from the Learner Guides on BBC Bitesize. <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zj44jxs">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zj44jxs</a> <b>Task 2</b> – PSHCE – Transition Unit – Friendship – Please consider the following questions and discuss them with an adult. What makes a good friendship? What are the first steps that you need to take to make a good friend? What would you do if a friendship were to make you unhappy? Do all friendships have to last forever? <b>Task 3</b> – Art – Futuristic London Skyline. What do you think London will be like in 100 years? Be creative and use your imagination. <b>Task 4</b> – PSHCE – Transition Unit – Complete the Getting Prepared 'Friends' activity on Purple Mash. <b>Task 5</b> – Computing – Coding on Purple Mash. I have set two different tasks so decide if you would rather do Option 1 or Option 2.
