




WEEKLY TASK SHEET

Below are the learning activities that Miss Gould would like you to complete this week.

Maths	Please complete a Maths lesson each day. White Rose and the BBC are working together to ensure resources are available for daily lessons. Use the links below for videos (both) and worksheets (BBC Bitesize): - White Rose - BBC Bitesize
English	Our topic this term is <i>Adventures</i>. Lesson 1 – Read Chapter 9 of Kensuke’s Kingdom. Lesson 2 – Read Chapter 10. Lesson 3 – <i>Pupil choice writing</i> : complete a piece of writing based on what you have just read. It could be a diary entry, a narrative from Kensuke’s perspective, a newspaper report or a playscript. The choice is yours! Lesson 4 – Re-draft your writing from the previous lesson. Lesson 5 – Write a book review of Kensuke’s Kingdom.
Spellings	Three spelling lists and tests have been set on Spelling Frame. Please practise your spellings every day and then complete the tests on Friday.
Reading	Please read for 15 minutes daily.
Topic Tasks	<p>Task 1 – Geography – Mapping Mountains: Click here Task 2 – Geography – Mountain Formation: Click here Task 3 – Art – Our school logo is an anchor. Create a piece of art with an anchor as the focus. You can work in any style that you like.</p>  <p>Task 4 – RE – What are the school’s Christian Values? Create a leaflet to introduce them to visitors to the school. Task 5 – Computing – Coding on Hour of Code (https://hourofcode.com/uk/learn) – Select one of the activities to complete.</p> <p>Year 6 Weekly Challenge: Make a mountain structure sowing the parts of a mountain or how mountains are formed. Use your skills with dry paper mache to make sure the structure is sturdy.
